
Hardware Setup Guide

The following items are required to complete the hardware setup:


1 x Vantage Plus Digital Ophthalmoscope

1 x 5 metres USB cable

- 1. Begin by unwrapping the items listed above from your kit.
- 2. Feed the mini USB cable (the smaller of the two ends) through the cable holder by un-buttoning it and feeding the cable through and buttoning it up as shown in Figure 1



3. Next Plug the mini USB cable into the mini USB socket as shown in Figure 2



4. Hardware set up is now complete and you are ready to start the software set up.

Quick Start Guide

Please follow these instructions if you have purchased a new Vantage Plus Digital or you have upgraded your existing instrument.

NOTE: Users who have upgraded their existing Vantage Plus Digital need to install the new software from the CD that has been provided to them. The upgrade will **NOT** work with previous software installations.

For full installation instructions with illustrations of each screen, see the guide on the CD. However, if you feel reasonably confident at installing software, the following steps should be sufficient. Note that several applications will be installed, each ending with a close or finish.

DO NOT PLUG IN THE CAMERA UNTIL PROMPTED TO DO SO!!

- 1. Insert CD.
- 2. The setup program will auto run. If it doesn't, run "Setup.exe" program from CD manually.
- 3. Follow the instructions on the window to install Vantage Digital camera drivers.
- 4. Plug the camera into the USB port <u>WHEN</u> prompted to do so.
- 5. Click on the "Install" button to install PnP service.
- 6. The Debut license is displayed, click Accept.
- 7. Finish the Debut installation without selecting any of the additional utilities (they are chargeable).
- 8. You can configure Debut settings at this point. Click the Options button to select the KS722OUP camera from the Webcam list.
- 9. If your PC has a microphone, select capture sound.

NOTE:

- To uninstall Vantage Digital EV02 and the related software modules, you should use the provided uninstall software program. Please refer to Uninstall Vantage Digital section, Software Setup and Quick Start Guide EP59-09871.

Device



Clicking on "Device" will enable you to view the image from the Vantage Plus Digital Indirect Ophthalmoscope.

Snap-Shot



Allows you take a still picture (like a normal camera). Click on the button to take a picture. Also works while recording a video.

Recordings (Ctrl + L Button on the Keyboard)





Is an area where all still pictures and video recordings are stored. Click on the button to view all videos and snap shots previously taken.

Record (F5 Button on the Keyboard)



Will commence video recording. Click on the button to start a new recording.

Pause (F6 Button on the Keyboard)



Will temporarily suspend recording, until resumed by pressing record.

Stop (F7 Button on the Keyboard)



Will permanently stop the current video recording, until it is started again.

Video File Format



This allows you to choose any specific file format you may wish to record in, we recommend that you use "WMV" as this is the default format used by Windows Media player. You can choose your file format by clicking on the drop down menu and select ".wmv"

Encoder Options

This varies with the Video File format you selected. If the video file format ".wmv" is selected, it will pop up a "Windows Media Encoding Settings" window as Figure 41, which allows you to choose any specific Video and Sound compressor, Video Bit rate and Sound format to record. We recommend that you use highest video bit rate (8192) to achieve highest video image quality.





Troubleshooting Guide

When I reinstall the program from disc, the windows operating system asks to restart computer. What can I do for it?

When reinstalling the program, a "Microsoft Windows" message appears as Figure 51 occasionally. You should select "Restart Later" to complete the installation. After completing the installation, please restart your computer.



When installing Debut Video Capture software, a warning message of "No capture devices are detected" appears. What can I do?

In the Vantage Digital installation procedure, after clicking the "Next" button on Installing Debut Vide Capture Software v1.63, there is a warning message window that pops up as Figure 52. In fact the Vantage Digital camera has been plugged in. Click on "Skip" button on "debut Video Capture Software" and Click on "Finish" button on "Installing Debut Video Capture Software v1.63" window to complete the installation. The installation has been done successfully, but the Debut Video capture software does not work because no Vantage Digital camera device has been found. To solve the problem:






What can I do if experiencing problems with video quality?

If you are experiencing problems with video quality, we have found the following techniques to be effective.

Plug the laptop to the mains power supply

Laptop/Notebook users are highly recommended to plug the laptop to the mains power supply whilst using the hardware, this prevents the laptop from slowing down to save battery.

Try different USB port

Because PC designs differ between manufactures, not all USB ports are suitable for high speed video. If you experience problems, try a different port.

Disable the built-in camera
